## Directions for Circulating Chris Slusser's Petition

- 1. You must be at least 18 years of age. However, if you are 17 years old and will be 18 by the date of the General Election, and are a U.S. citizen, you may also circulate this petition.
- 2. You may circulate this petition regardless of whether you have ever voted in a Republican primary, a Democratic Primary or no Primary Election or General Election at all.
- 3. You must personally witness all of the signatures that are made on this petition no exceptions.
- 4. You may circulate this petition anywhere, but the signers must be registered voters in Madison County.
- 5. You may also sign this petition if you are a registered voter within Madison County.
- 6. You may not circulate petitions for more than one political party.
- 7. Petitions with fewer than 10 names do count. If you are not able to fill an entire petition, send in the partially completed petition. Each signature counts.
- 8. If you learn a signature is not valid, do not worry. Bad signatures do not knock out other good signatures or invalidate a petition. HOWEVER, known bad signatures should be brought to the attention of the campaign, so that they can be officially deleted. A circulator who recklessly and routinely disregards the signature gathering rules may have an entire sheet stricken even though some signatures are valid.
- 9. You must sign as the circulator of the petition before a Notary Public licensed in Illinois and the Notary Public must affix his/her seal or stamp. Most banks and libraries will notarize free of charge. Do not sign the circulator's affidavit until you are seated in front of a notary no exceptions.
- 10. DO NOT number the petition page.

Directions for Signing
Chris Slusser's Petition

- 1. You must be a registered voter in Madison County. You need not have voted in a previous Republican Primary and may even have voted in a Democrat Primary or not even have voted in a primary at all.
- 2. You must sign your name as you are registered to vote. For example, William E. Jones, not Bill Jones.
- 3. DO NOT use ditto marks for any part of an address or county.
- 4. You must use the address where you are registered to vote. Post Office boxes are usually not acceptable.
- 5. You MAY NOT sign petitions for candidates of more than one political party in the same election.
- 6. You may sign only once. You cannot sign another person's name, even a family member, on a petition.
